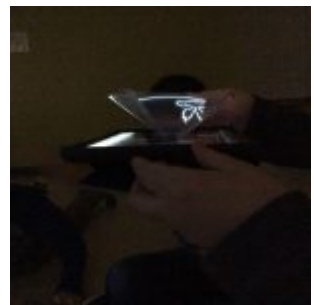
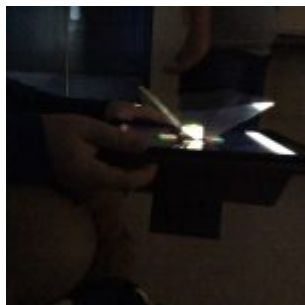
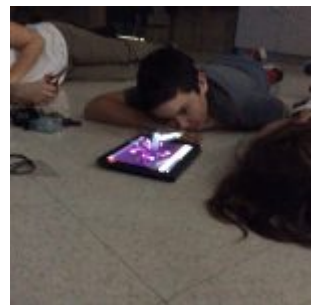
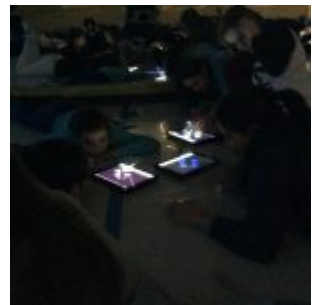
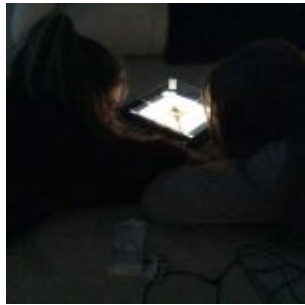


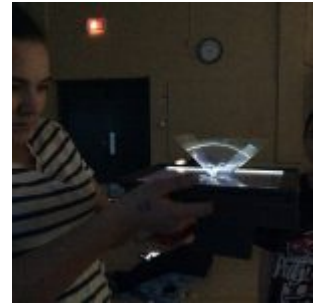
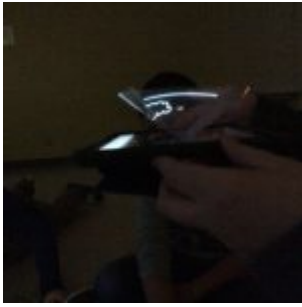
Winter Stop Motion Video Clips
