

## Convince

The word of the day is **convince**.

**Convince** is a verb. When you **convince** someone of something, you make the person believe you or do what you ask.

“Persuade” is a synonym of **convince**.

For example, “We tried to **convince** our teacher to give us less homework.”

“How do I **convince** my parents to adopt a puppy?”

“I am not **convinced** that she is telling the truth.”



## Hilarious

The word of the day is **hilarious**.

**Hilarious** is an adjective. It means very funny.

“Entertaining” is the synonym of **hilarious**.

For example, “This joke is **hilarious**.”

“He is such a **hilarious** actor!”

“This book is absolutely **hilarious**!”



## Deliver

The word of the day is **deliver**.

**Deliver** is a verb.

It means to send something to a particular person or place.

“Bring” is the synonym of **deliver**.

For example, “They don’t **deliver** mail on week-ends”

“We had three pizzas **delivered** to our hotel room”

“Some supermarkets **deliver** groceries to your house.”
