

Nouns (singular, plural)

Singular : a + consonant
an + a, e, o, i, u
the, this, that

Plural: ___s / es / ies / ves / exceptions
the, these, those

Noun + s :

cat – cats	dog – dogs
snake – snakes	sheriff – sheriffs
boy – boys	tattoo – tattoos
letter – letters	parent – parents
car – cars	tree – trees
apple – apples	banana – bananas

O (not - oo), x, s, ch, sh, z + es :

hero – heroes	witch – witches
fox – foxes	brush – brushes
bus – buses	class – classes

Consonant + y → ies :

cherry – cherries	baby – babies
puppy – puppies	lady – ladies

Ends with f/fe (not - ff), → ves :

elf – elves	knife – knives
wolf – wolves	leaf – leaves

Exceptions :

man – men	mouse – mice
woman – women	fish – fish
child – children	fruit – fruit
person – people	foot – feet
sheep – sheep	tooth – teeth
goose – geese	deer – deer
