

Advice

The word of the day is **advice**.

Advice is a noun. It is an opinion that you offer to help someone make a decision.

“Recommendation” is a synonym of **advice**.

For example, “My **advice** to you is to be patient.”

“I don’t need your **advice**.”

“My dad gave me a good **advice**.”



Embarrass

The word of the day is **embarrass**.

Embarrass is a verb. It means to make someone feel bad and uncomfortable.

“Humiliate” is a synonym of **embarrass**.

For example, “You **embarrassed** me in front of everybody.”

“I don’t want to **embarrass** myself in front of my friends.”



Stumble

The word of the day is **stumble**.

Stumble is a verb. It means to lose balance while walking or running. It also means to encounter someone by chance.

“Trip” is a synonym of **stumble**.

For example, “He **stumbled** down the stairs.”

“I **stumbled** over the rock in the street.”

“Last Friday, I **stumbled** across my old friend at a restaurant.”



Allowance

The word of the day is **allowance**.

Allowance is a noun. It is a sum of money that you receive on a regular basis.

“Salary” is a synonym of **allowance**.

For example, “I get **allowance** for doing chores.”

“Do your parents give you **allowance**?”

“I am saving my **allowance** to get a new iPad.”
