

Earn

The word of the day is **earn**.

Earn is a verb.

To **earn** means to work for money or some other kind of reward.

“Merit” is a synonym of **earn**.

For example, “You earn trust through honesty.”

“We **earn** extra points when we do a good job.”

“What can I do to **earn** \$100?”

“I prefer to earn it. It makes me appreciate it more.”



Decorate

The word of the day is **decorate**.

Decorate is a verb.

When you **decorate** something, you add to it to make it look prettier or special.

“Embellish” is a synonym of **decorate**.

For example, “Molly **decorated** her room.”

“I like to **decorate** cupcakes with my little sister.”

“For Christmas, we always **decorate** a Christmas tree.”



Rude

The word of the day is **rude**.

Rude is an adjective. A **rude** person has bad manners.

“Impolite” is a synonym of **rude**.

For example, “I’m sorry I was so **rude**.”

“It’s **rude** to interrupt someone when they are talking.”

“In China, it’s not **rude** to burp after a meal.”

“It’s **rude** to spit on the ground.”
