

Vanish

The word of the day is **vanish**.

Vanish is a verb. It means to go away or disappear suddenly.

“Disappear” is a synonym of **vanish**.

For example, “I put the keys in my pocket, but they just **vanished**.”

“The car **vanished** in the night.”

“The pain **vanished** after he took an aspirin.”



Complain

The word of the day is **complain**.

Complain is a verb. It means to be angry or unhappy about something.

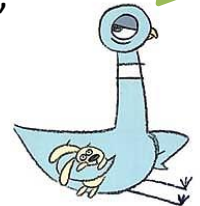
“Nag and whine” are synonyms of **complain**.

For example, “She never **complains** about chores. She likes to help out.”

“John **complains** of headaches.”

“Kelly always finds something to **complain** about.”

Expect

The word of the day is **expect**.

Expect is a verb. When you **expect** something, you think it will happen.

“Look forward” is a synonym of **expect**.

For example, “I **expect** my students to do their homework.”

“My parents **expect** me to work hard at school.”

“What did you **expect** me to do?”

“I am scared when I don’t know what to **expect**.”

“I didn’t **expect** this to be so difficult.”
