The word of the day is **borrow**.

Borrow is a verb. When you **borrow** something from someone, you use it for a short time. Then you return it. "Rent" is a synonym of **borrow**.

For example, "Can I borrow your pencil, please?"

"She borrowed five dollars from her friend."

"I want to borrow an English book from the library."



Fidget

The word of the day is **fidget**.

Fidget is a verb.

It means to move your body nervously or impatiently.

"Wiggle" is a synonym of **fidget**.

For example, "John always fidgets in the class."

"Do you fidget or sit still while at your desk?"

"Some students need to fidget to stay focused."



The word of the day is **celebrate**.

Celebrate is a verb.

It means to make something very special.

You can **celebrate** your birthday.

"Ignore" is the opposite of celebrate.

For example, "We celebrate Halloween on the 31st of October."

"Chinese people do not celebrate Christmas; they celebrate Spring Festival."

"That's great! I think we should celebrate it!"

"Do you celebrate World Nutella Day?"
